Directions to I 675

From Cincinnati:

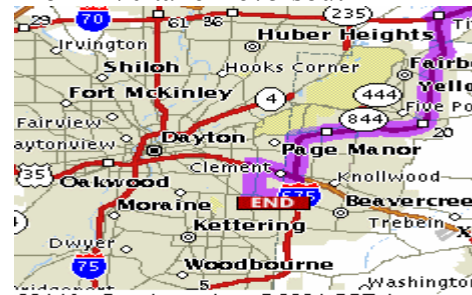
Take I-75 North
From I-75 take I 675 north

From West of Dayton:

From I-70 East, take I-75 South
From I-75 take US 35 East
From US 35, take I-675 South

From Columbus:

Take I-70 West
From I-70 take I-675 south



From I-675:

Exit at Indian Ripple Rd.

Turn west on Indian Ripple Rd. (If you are coming from the north it will be a right. If you come from the south it will be on your left.)

Turn right (north) onto County Line Rd.

Turn left (west) onto Shakertown Rd.

Turn right (north) on Founders Dr.

Pass the first entrance to 1900 Founders Dr. (past visitors parking).

Turn right into the second parking lot, park in general parking.
